### Code of Conduct

As participants in the Foundations in the Classics program, we ask all students to respect the following guidelines to ensure a safe, respectful, and enriching environment for everyone.

### Conduct in Class

- **Punctuality:** Arrive on time for all classes and activities. Late arrivals disrupt the learning experience.
- **Attention:** Be attentive to teachers and fellow students. Listen actively and contribute thoughtfully, and avoid interrupting others.
- **Participation:** Engage fully in class discussions and activities. Your insights and ideas enrich the learning experience for everyone.
- **Preparedness:** Bring required materials to class, such as notebooks, pens, and any assigned readings.
- **Appropriate Behaviour:** Maintain a respectful and courteous attitude. Disruptive behaviour, including chatting, using phones, or other distractions, is not permitted.

### Conduct on Campus Grounds

- **Respect for Property:** Treat the campus facilities, equipment, and grounds with care. Any damage caused intentionally or through negligence may result in consequences.
- **Personal Responsibility:** Keep personal belongings organised and secure. Champion College is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **Supervision:** Remain within designated areas at all times. Wandering away from the group or leaving campus without permission is strictly prohibited.
- **Appropriate Language:** Use language that reflects courtesy and respect for others. Offensive or inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
- **Dress Code:** Wear neat, modest clothing and appropriate footwear while on campus.

### General Expectations

- **Respect for Others:** Show kindness and consideration to peers, staff, and visitors on campus. Bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind is unacceptable.
- **Follow Instructions:** Adhere to the instructions of teachers, program staff, and campus personnel at all times.
- **Safety First:** Prioritise safety in all activities. Report any incidents, concerns, or emergencies to a staff member immediately.

### Consequences for Misconduct

Failure to follow the Code of Conduct may result in a warning, parental notification, or dismissal from the program, depending on the severity of the behaviour.
